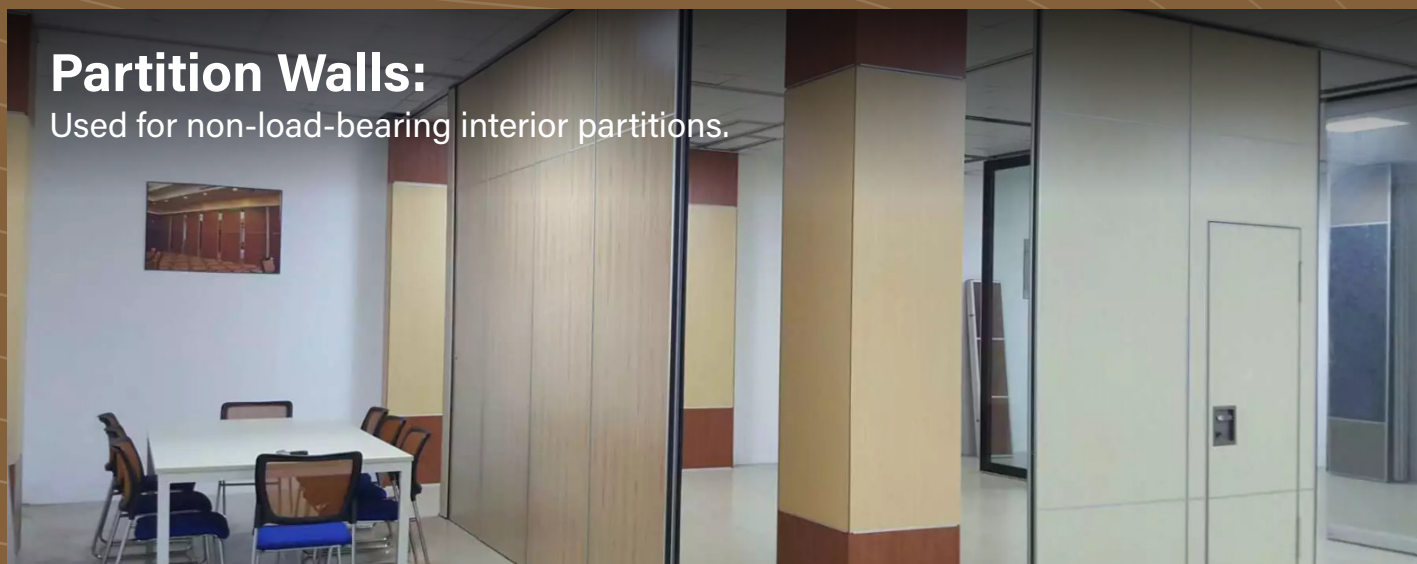
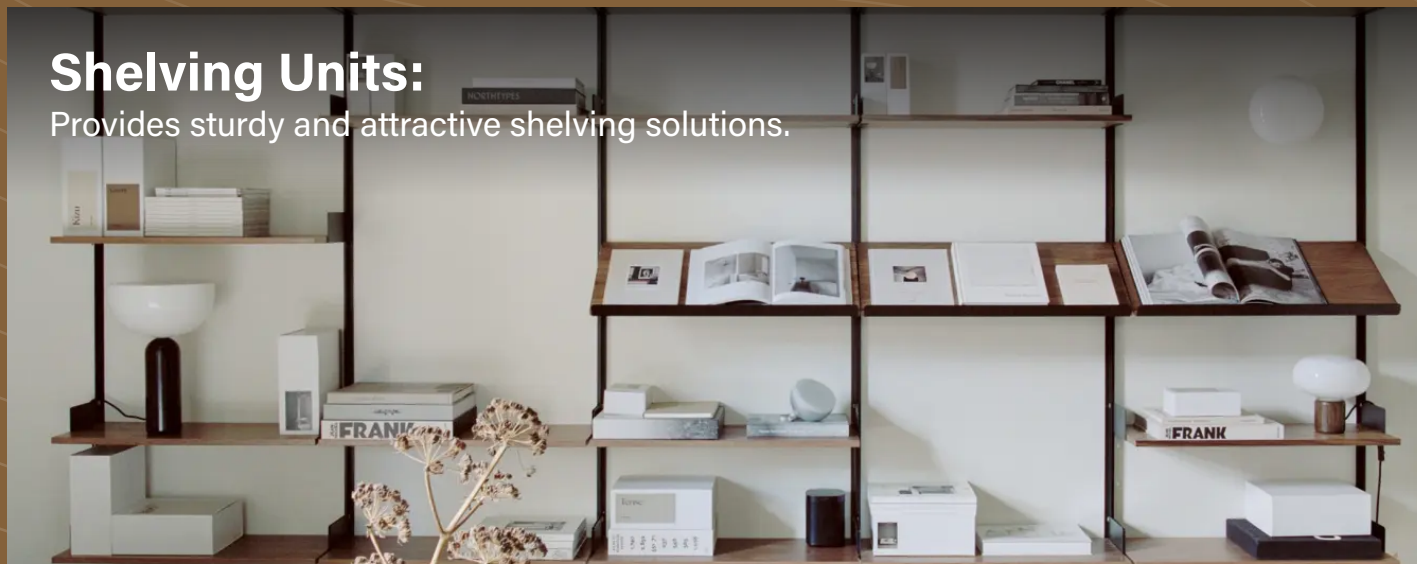
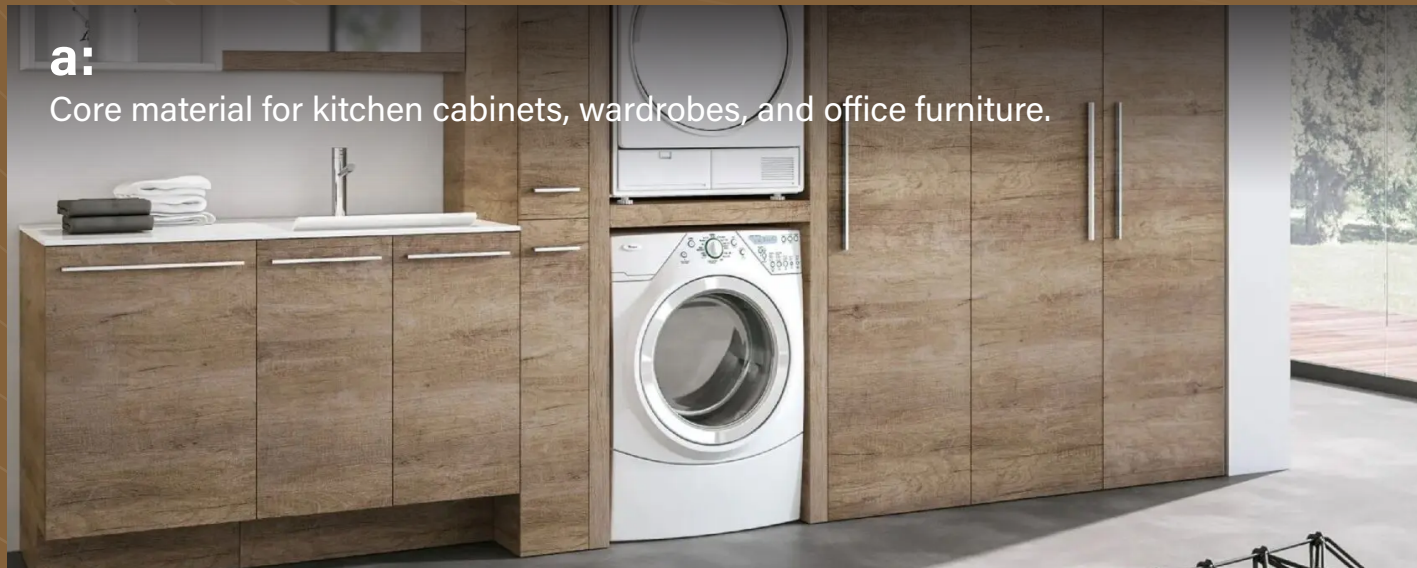

Installation & Care Guide

Installation and Maintenance

To ensure the best outcome and a long-lasting finish, please follow these guidelines, paying special attention to moisture protection.

Storage & Handling:

Store flat and level in a dry, acclimatized environment.

Cutting & Machining:

Use sharp, carbide-tipped saw blades with a high tooth count to minimize chipping of the melamine surface.

Edge Banding:

Edge banding is essential for all exposed edges to prevent moisture ingress and provide a finished look.

Fastening:

Use screws or fasteners appropriate for chipboard or MDF, avoiding over-tightening.

Safety:

Wear PPE, including dust masks, as cutting can produce fine dust.

Care & Maintenance:

Clean the melamine surface with a soft, clean cloth and a mild, non-abrasive detergent.

Crucial: Avoid exposing un-banded edges or core material to water or high humidity, as this can cause swelling and irreversible damage. Wipe up spills on the surface promptly.

Use trivets for hot items and cutting boards for food preparation to protect the surface.
